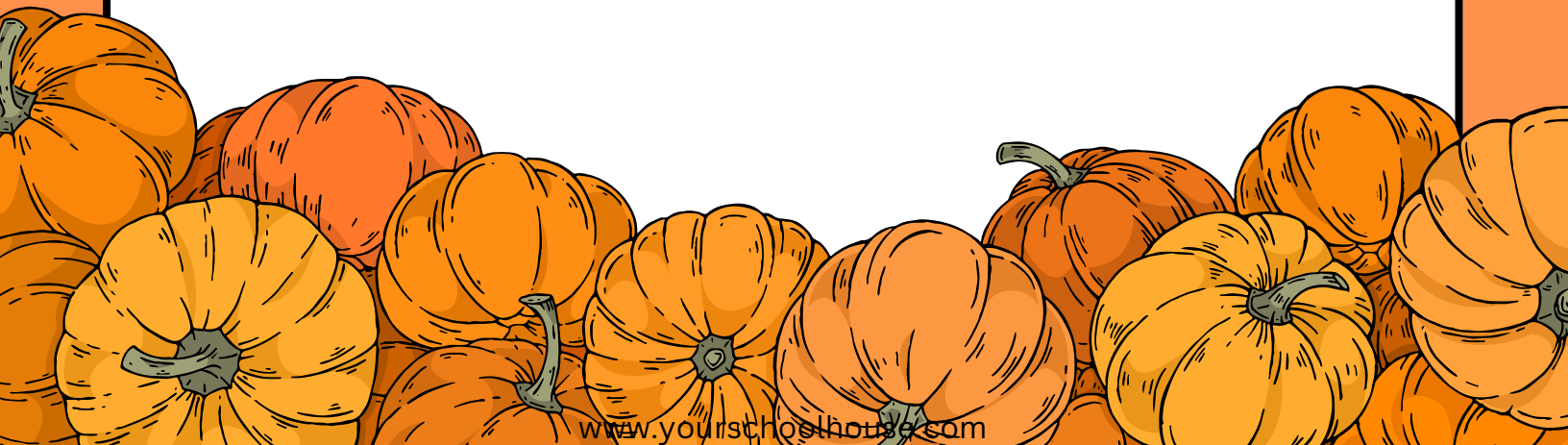


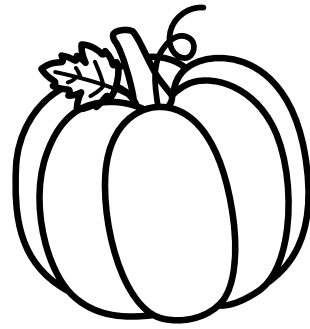

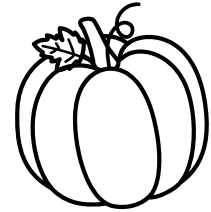

Let's get creative! Use the word bank provided to draw, color and label the various parts of a pumpkin.

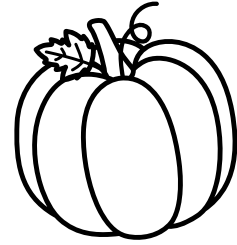
